UNDER THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Under Section 3 of the above Ordinance the proposed construction of a health centre on the land described in the schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a public work.

2. Under Section 4 of the said Ordinance the Commissioner of Lands and Mines, together with his agents, servants or workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the who e or of part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

A piece of land situate on the right bank of the Demerara River and being a portion of Lot No. 31 commencing about 380 feet below the mouth of a small unnamed creek and its boundaries extending thence N 104° 26′ (ded. tr.) 170 feet; thence N 189° 39′ (ded. tr.) 110 feet; thence N 64° 59′ 34″ (ded. tr.) 170.82 feet; thence N 14° 26′ (ded. tr.) 24.9 feet; thence N 284° 26′ (ded. tr.) 314 feet to the Demerara River thence along the right bank Demerara River to the point of commencement and containing an area of decimal three five one nine English acre (.3519 English acre).
