ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 258).

UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Paralytic Rabies) Order, 1961.
2. For the purpose of this Order it is hereby directed that the expression "animal" in section 2 of the Animals Diseases Ordinance shall include the domestic cat.
3. Owing to the presence therein of cases of paralytic rabies, the area described in the schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be for the purpose of the abovementioned Ordinance an area infected with paralytic rabies.

SCHEDULE

The left bank of the Essequibo River between Aurora and Adventure and including the area of land taken in by extending westward for 10 miles from the river to points opposite to Aurora and Adventure respectively.
