ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 23 (5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION  
ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE  
GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Construction) (No. 2) Order, 1961.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed within the Buxton-Friendship Area, the Drainage and Irrigation Works described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

- (a) A distributary with a dam on each side along the old Buxton-Friendship middle walk from the Conservancy to the Crown Dam;
- (b) A side line in Friendship East from the Conservancy to the Crown Dam;
- (c) A side line in Buxton West from the Conservancy to the Crown Dam;
- (d) Two greenheart boxes, 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 30ft., in the Crown Dam at the Friendship East and Buxton West side lines;
- (e) Two greenheart panels in the distributary near the Crown Dam to form a lock for water transport;
- (f) A greenheart bridge on the Crown Dam over the new distributary;  
and
- (g) Fencing the new distributary and outside perimeter.
