

## BRITISH GUIANA

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 179).

WHEREAS by Order in Council No. 82 of 1960 made on the 10th September, 1960, the proposed construction of a canal with dams on both sides and a sluice on the land described in the schedule to this Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Ordinance;

AND WHEREAS by the said Order in Council the Director of Drainage and Irrigation together with his agents or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Ordinance aforesaid to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS that part of section 6 of the Ordinance aforesaid which provides for the laying of a plan of the land to be acquired before the Governor in Council has been complied with:

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Ordinance aforesaid, it is hereby declared that the land described in the schedule to this Order is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Land of Canaan) Order, 1961.

## SCHEDULE

A tract of land being part of Plantation Land of Canaan situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the County of Demerara and the Colony of British Guiana the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at a point along the centre line of the Public Roadway distant 596 ft. north of the northern edge of the McLeod trench and proceeding along a line S. 86° 42' W. to the right bank of the Demerara River, thence along the aforesaid right bank of the Demerara River for a distance of 415 feet thence along a line N. 86° 42' E. to a point situated 245 ft. from the centre line of the Public Roadway and on the eastern side of the aforesaid Public Roadway, thence along a line S. 2° 45' E. for a distance of 55 ft. thence along a line N. 86° 42' E. to the western toe of the conservancy dam, thence along the aforesaid western toe of the conservancy dam for a distance of 319.4 ft. thence along a line S. 86° 42' E. for a distance of 7162 ft. thence along a line S. 2° 45' E. for a distance of 55 ft. thence along a line S. 86° 42' W. back to the point of commencement.
