ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 33 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 3(1) OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS: —

1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (North West Amerindian District) Order, 1961.

2. Shops, other than restaurants, parlours, cookshops and barbers' and hairdressers' establishments, situate in the North West Amerindian District as described in the North West Amerindian District Order, 1953*, are hereby permitted to be open during the hours set out in the schedule to this Order.
