ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 150).

UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Plaisance Village District (Elections) Order, 1961.

2. For the purpose of the election of councillors, the Plaisance Village District is hereby divided into three divisions, namely, the North Division, the Central Division, and the South Division, the boundaries of which are described in the schedule hereto.

3. The number of councillors appointed to be elected by each division shall be as follows:—

- (a) by the North Division, five councillors;
- (b) by the Central Division, four councillors; and
- (c) by the South Division, three councillors.

SCHEDULE

- (Boundaries of the North Division)
 On the North by the Foreshore.
 On the South by the railway line.
 On the East by Graham Street.
 On the West by Victoria Branch Road.
- (Boundaries of the Central Division) On the North by the railway line. On the South by Ramos Street. On the East by Graham Street. On the West by Victoria Branch Road.
- 3. (Boundaries of the South Division) On the North by Ramos Street. On the South by the East Demerara Water Conservancy. On the East by Graham Street. On the West by Victoria Branch Road.
