**BRITISH GUIANA.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Amendment) Order, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) Order, 1961\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. Article 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso:—

“Provided that any horse may be imported into the Colony from the United Kingdom if there is produced to the satisfaction of the Director a certificate from the Ministry of Agriculture of the United Kingdom showing that such horse —

- (a) had been kept for at least two months immediately prior to its departure for the Colony at a place with a radius of fifteen miles which was at the time and had been for at least two months previously free from foot and mouth disease, and
- (b) did not pass through any area infected with foot and mouth disease on its way to the place of embarkation.”
