UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the General Traffic Directions (Amen'd-ment) Order, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the General Traffic Directions*.
