MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, (Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) Order, 1961.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st September, 1961.

2. All vehicles approaching Cornhill Street along Brickdam shall stop before entering or crossing Cornhill Street.

- 3. All vehicles approaching Sussex Street along
 - (a) Russell Street, and
 - (b) Charles Street

shall stop before entering Sussex Street.

4. All vehicles approaching Carmichael Street along New Market Street shall stop before entering or crossing Carmichael Street.

5. All vehicles approaching D'Urban Street along —

- (a) Lime Street,
- (b) Louisa Row,
- (c) Hardinha Street, and
- (d) Cemetery Road,

shall stop before entering or crossing D'Urban Street.

6. All vehicles approaching Brickdam along —

- (a) Manget Place,
- (b) Chalmers Place, and
- (c) Winter Place,

shall stop before entering or crossing Brickdam.

7. All vehicles approaching Hadfield Street along Lime Street shall stop before entering or crossing Hadfield Street.

8. All vehicles approaching Broad Street along Charles Street shall stop before entering or crossing Broad Street.

9. All vehicles approaching Sea Wall Road along Battery Road shall stop before entering Sea Wall Road.

10. All vehicles approaching Fourth Street along

- (a) Light Street, and
- (b) Albert Street,

shall stop before entering or crossing Fourth Street.

11. All vehicles approaching Third Street along —

- (a) Light Street, and
- (b) Cummings Street, from the north,

shall stop before entering or crossing Third Street.

12. All vehicles approaching Saffon Street along Sussex Street shall stop before entering or crossing Saffon Street.

13. All vehicles approaching David Street, Kitty, along Lamaha Street, Kitty, shall stop before entering or crossing David Street, Kitty.
