THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1961.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (3) of section 1 of the British Guiana (Constitution) Order in Council, 1961, that the provisions of article 22 and Parts III and VI of the Constitution of British Guiana shall come into force on such date after the appointed date as the Governor, acting in his discretion, may by order published in the Gazette appoint;

AND WHEREAS the last mentioned date was proclaimed to be the eighteenth day of July, 1961:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provisions of the said subsection, I do hereby appoint the fifth day of September, 1961, as the date on which the provisions of article 22 and Parts III and VI of the said Constitution shall come into force.
