THE KAIETEUR NATIONAL PARK ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 188).

UNDER SECTION 2(2) OF THE KAIETEUR NATIONAL PARK ORDI-NANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Kaieteur National Park (Variation of Boundaries) Order, 1961.

2. The boundaries of the Kaieteur National Park as defined in the schedule to the Kaieteur National Park Ordinance^{*} are hereby varied by the substitution therefor of the boundaries defined in the schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Boundaries of Kaieteur National Park.

Commencing at a point on the left bank Potaro River, two hundred fect below the Tukeit Rest House Compound, thence along the trail to the Korume Creek, thence up the Korume Creek to its source, thence to and including Menzies landing on the left bank Potaro River, thence across the Potaro River to its right bank, thence inland for a distance of one quarter of a mile, thence downwards and parallel to the right bank Potaro River at a distance of one quarter of a mile to an unnamed tributary of the Potaro River on its right bank about three hundred feet below the foot of Tukeit Falls, thence down the left bank of that tributary to the right bank Potaro River, thence across the Potaro River to the point of commencement.
