THE LABOUR ACT

(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) (Amendment) Order 1981, and shall come into operation on 7th December, 1981. Citation and commencement.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following manner — Amendment of the Principal Order.

- (a) by the deletion, in the definition of "watchmen", in clause 2 thereof, of the words "to watch over a private dwelling by the person residing therein, or";
- (b) by the substitution, in clause 3 (1) thereof for the words "33.00" of the words "69.52";
- (c) by the substitution, in clause 3 (2) thereof, for the words "68 cents" of the words "1.58";
- (d) by the insertion in clause 3 (2) thereof, immediately after the words "per hour", of the words "or \$12.71 per day"; and
- (e) by the substitution in clause 4 thereof, for the words "\$1.02 cents per hour", wherever they occur, of the words "one and one half times the rate at which he would be paid under this Order".

3. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order a watchman was in receipt of a wage at a rate higher than that prescribed by clause 2 of this Order, the employer shall nevertheless continue to pay to the watchman wages at the higher rate. Higher Rates when payable
