**THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT
(Cap. 62:05)**

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government Buildings) Order 1985.
2. The land described in the Schedule hereunder, together with all buildings and erections thereon, is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A piece of land containing an area of 1.10 (one decimal one nought) acres and known as lot B, part of the abandoned plantation Belfield, cum annexis, situate on the east sea coast, in the county of Demerara, and colony of British Guiana, as shown and defined on a plan by E. S. E. Parker, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 28th day of May, 1940, and deposited in the Deeds Registry on the 21st day of June, 1940, with the buildings and erections thereon, with the right of drainage through the said plantation Belfield.
