(Cap. 27:11)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 6 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATIO OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—
- 1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices Citation and (Holders' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional ment. Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1984.
- 2. Clause 4 of the Principer is hereby amended by Amendment the substitution for the words 8.400 "\$7.200" in both places of the Principhere they occur, "\$6,000" and , 00" of the words "\$10,800", pal Order. "\$9,600", "\$8,400" and "\$7.200" respectively.
- 3. Clause 5(1) of the Principal Order is hereby amended Amendment by the substitution for the words beginning with "the Chancellor" of the Principand ending with "other judge" of the words "every judge" and Pal Order. for the words "\$332" and "\$377" of the words "\$720" and "\$810" respectively.
- 4. Clause 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by Amendment the substitution for paragraph (1) of the following paragraph of the Principal Order.

 - "(1) In respect of the use of his motor car on official duty there shall be paid —

- (a) to every judge of the Supreme Court, the Ombudsman, the Director of Fullic rosecutions and the Augitor General a travelling allowance consisting of a fixed allowance of \$700 per month and a mileage allowance payable under the Scale A rate applicable to public officers from time to time; and
- (b) to the Chairman of the Elections Commission, the Commissioner of Police and every member of a Service Commission (not being a judge of the Supreme Court) a travelling allowance at the Scale C rate applicable to public officers from time to time, "

such travelling allowance being payable subject to the conditions of payment of travelling allowance from time to time applying to officers in the public service.".
