THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 5 AND 6 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER —
- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices Citation and Commence (Remuneration of Holders) Order 1985.
- (2) Clause 2(a) of this Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1983.
- (3) Clause 2(b) of this Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1984.
- 2. The Schedule to the Act is hereby amended as Amendment of the Schedule to the follows
 - (a) by the substitution for the words "\$57,600" of the words "\$72,000", for the words "\$52,800", "\$48,000" and "\$42,000", wherever they occur, of the words "\$66,000", "\$60,000" and "\$54,000" respectively;
 - (b) in the second proviso, by the substitution for the words "of 4,800 per annum" of the words "annually equivalent to the difference between the salary payable annually to the Chancellor and that payable annually to the Chief Justice".
