1. This Order may be cited a the National Security (Miscellaneous Provision) (Amnesty) Order 1985.

Amnestly periodi 2.(1) Any person who surrender any firearm, ammunition or explosive at a police station to the officer in charge of the police station or elsewhere to any policeman during the period commencing on 1st October, 1985 and ending on 31st October, 1985 shall not be pro-secuted under the Firearm Act or section 23 of the Act for illagally purchasing, acquiring or possessing such firearm, ammunition or explosive prior to the time of such surrender or at that time.

(2) Any per on who surrender any firearm, ammunition or ex-plosive under paragraph (1) hall be issued with a receipt therefor by the officer in charge of the police station where it was surrendered or by the policeman to whom it was surrendered.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order grants amnesty to per on in illegal possession of any firearm, ammunition or explosive if they surrender it to a policeman during the period specified for that purpose, that i from 1 t October 1985 to 31 t
