THE PENSIONS (PRESIDENT, PARLIAMENTARY AND  
SPECIAL OFFICES) ACT

(Cap. 27:03)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 2 OF THE PENSIONS (PRESIDENT, PARLIAMENTARY AND SPECIAL OFFICES) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensions (President, <sup>Citation.</sup> Parliamentary and Special Offices) (Designation) Order 1985.

2. The office of Director of the Workers' Education Unit <sup>Specified</sup> within the Ministry of Higher Education is designated as a <sup>qualifying</sup> specified qualifying office for the purpose of the Act. <sup>office.</sup>

3. Notwithstanding clause 2, service in the office mentioned in that clause between the 1st January, 1981 and the 30th April, 1982 shall be service as a legislator for the purposes of the Act only if that service was followed by service of the holder thereof in such other office as would qualify to be reckoned as service as a legislator for the purposes of the Act. <sup>Service.</sup>
