IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 17 OF THE STATE LANDS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOW-ING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the State Lands Regula-Citation tions^{*}, may be cited as the State Lands (Amendment) Regulations 1985.
