ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 23(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Construction) (No. 6) Order, 1961.
2. The Board shall cause to be constructed the drainage and irrigation work described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Greenheart check sluice at the bridge across the facade trench on the Ketting between Courtland and Fyrish about 3,000 feet north of the Public Road on the Corentyne Coast, in the County of Berbice and Colony of British Guiana, within the Fyrish Drainage and Irrigation Area.
