MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, (Chapter 192).

- UNDER SECTION 18 (3) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH I OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Cane Grove Drainage and Irrigation Area (Boundaries) Order, 1961.
- 2. The boundaries of the Cane Grove Drainage and Irrigation Area as defined in the schedule to the Drainage and Irrigation (Declaration of Area) Ordinance, 1961*, are hereby varied by the substitution therefor of the boundaries defined in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

On the North by the common boundary between Plantations Veereeniging and Mary's Hope from the toe of the eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal to the left bank of the Mahaica River.

On the East by the left bank of the Mahaica River from the common boundary between Plantations Veerceniging and Mary's Hope to the northern boundary of Plantation Orange

Nassau.

On the South — by the northern boundary of Plantation Orange Nassau, Grants 1682, 1681, Lease A5929 and that area of Crown Lands west of Lease A5929, from the left bank of the Mahaica River to the eastern boundary of the East Demerara Water Conservancy; by the eastern boundary of the East Demerara Water Conservancy from the aforesaid northern boundary of that area of Crown Land west of Lease A5929 to the northern boundary of the East Demerara Water Conservancy; and thence by the northern boundary of the East Demerara Water Conservancy to the toe of

eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal.

On the West by the toe of the eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal from the northern boundary of the East Demerara Water Con-

servancy, to the common boundary between Plantations

Veereeniging and Mary's Hope.
