THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, (Chapter 258)

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Wild Carnivores) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Wild Carnivores) (No. 2) Order, 1955, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.
- 2. Article 3 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end thereof and the insertion thereafter of the following proviso—

"Provided that nothing in this Order shall prevent the importation of a lion cub from the United States of America by the Royal Agricultural and Commercial Society to be kept at the Zoo, Botanic Gardens".

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 2nd December, 1961.
