THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, (Chapter 179)

UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Land of Canaan) (Amendment) Order, 1962 and shall be construed and read as one with the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Land of Canaan) Order, 1961, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date of the coming into operation of the Principal Order.
- 2. The Principal Order is hereby altered by the substitution for the schedule thereto of the schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

A tract of land comprising strips "A", "B" and "C" being part of Plantation Land of Canaan situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the County of Demerara and Colony of British Guiana the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at a point on the western side of the Public Roadway approximately 40 feet west of the centre line of the aforesaid Public Roadway and 596.0 feet north of the northern edge of the Mc Leod trench, and extending thence S. 86° 42′ W. for a distance of 1697.6 feet to the right bank of the Demerara River, thence N. 5° 24′ E. for a distance of 415.0 feet along the aforesaid right bank of the Demerara River, thence N. 86° 42′ E. for a distance of 1887.3 feet to a point approximately 207 feet east of the centre line of the Public Roadway, thence S. 2° 45′ E for a distance of 55.0 feet, thence N. 86° 42′ E. for a distance of 7268.3 feet to the western toe of the Conservancy dam, thence S. 16° 45′ W. for a distance of 319.4 feet along the aforesaid western toe of the Conservancy dam, thence S. 86° 42′ W. for a distance of 7162.0 feet, thence S. 2° 45′ E for a distance of 55.0 feet, thence S. 86° 42′ W. for a distance of 247 feet to the point of commencement.
