THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Wild Carnivores) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 1962, and shall be construed and read as one with the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Wild Carnivores) (No. 2) Order, 1955*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. Article 3 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of the proviso thereof and the addition thereafter of the following proviso —

“Provided further that nothing in this Order shall prevent the importation from any country for a limited period of time with the permission of the Director of Agriculture of any of the animals mentioned in the first schedule to this Order for the purpose of exhibiting such animals at a circus or such other entertainment, provided that the animals are first examined by a Government veterinary surgeon before they are landed and a certificate to the effect that the animals are in good health is first issued by such veterinary surgeon and endorsed by him as being valid for a specified period of time, and that such animals are kept during that time at a place approved by a Government veterinary surgeon who shall have power to examine them from time to time.”
