UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE SUPREME COURT ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

The Magistrate's Court, New Amsterdam, is hereby proclaimed to be a place at which sittings of the Supreme Court in the exercise of its civil jurisdiction in the County of Berbice from the 17th day of February, 1962, until further orders, may be held.
