

ORDER

REGULATION 44 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1939.

UNDER REGULATION 44 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1939,
AND WITH THE CONSENT OF THE GOVERNOR, IT IS ORDERED
BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This order may be cited as the Control and Distribution (Foodstuffs and Drugs) Order, 1962.

2. No wholesaler of articles of the nature of foodstuffs or drugs as set out in the First and Second Schedules hereto shall sell or offer or expose for sale such articles to any person other than a person duly authorised in writing by the Competent Authority to purchase the same.

3. No person shall purchase or offer to purchase any articles of the nature of foodstuffs or drugs from a wholesaler unless he is authorised in writing by the Competent Authority to purchase or to offer to purchase such articles.

4. Every wholesaler of articles specified in the Schedules to this order shall submit to the Competent Authority in writing not later than seven days after the coming into operation of this order a complete statement of the stocks of such articles held by him in connection with his trade or business at the date of the commencement of operation of this order and shall thereafter submit a return to the Competent Authority of all such articles received into stock by the wholesaler within seven days after such receipt.

5. This order shall come into operation forthwith.

Flour.
Split peas.
Salted and pickled fish.
Condensed milk.
Evaporated milk.
Powdered milk.
Canned meat and fish.
Potatoes.
Cooking butter.
Pickled pork products.
Pickled beef.
Salt.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Antibiotics.
Antiseptics.
Cotton wool.
Surgical dressings including lint, bandages and gauze.
Anaesthetics.
Narcotics.
Antropine.
Adrenalin.
Tranquilisers.
Sulpha drugs.
Vaccine.
Antihistamines.
Hypodermic syringes.
Antisan cream.
