ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Anthrax) Order, 1962.
2. Owing to the presence in the area described in the schedule to this Order of cases of anthrax and the necessity for preventing the spread of such disease, the area aforesaid is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the Animals Diseases Ordinance, an area infected with anthrax.

SCHEDULE

That area which is the southern portion of Plantation Toevlugt owned by Mr. Arjoon Rupi and situated on the West Bank of the Demerara River bounded on the north by the 'B' line poulder irrigation canal, on the east by the public road, on the south by the boundary with Plantation La Retraite and on the west by the boundary with Plantation Middlesex.
