THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955,
(No. 30 of 1955)

UNDER SECTION 9(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting) (No. 1) Order, 1962.

2. The works described in the schedule hereto in the Mahaicony to Abary Drainage and Irrigation Area shall vest in and become the property of the Drainage and Irrigation Board.

SCHEDULE

- (1) A bridge across the irrigation trench known as the Burma Drain slightly north of its junction with the Esau and Jacob drain.
- (2) A bridge across the irrigation trench known as the Burma Drain about 2000 feet south of its junction with the Esau and Jacob drain.
- (3) A bridge across the Esau and Jacob drain slightly east of its junction with the irrigation trench known as the Burma Drain.
