THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961.

(No. 10 of 1961)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Order, 1962.

2. The register of electors for every electoral district appointed by Order dated the 8th February, 1961, under section 2 (1) of the British Guiana (Electoral Provisions) Order in Council, 1960, shall be revised in accordance with Parts II and III of the first schedule to the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Ordinance, 1961, upon the coming into operation of this Order.

3. The 1st August, 1962, is hereby appointed as the day with reference to which every register to which this Order relates shall be revised.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order directs the revision of the electoral registers in pursuance of the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Ordinance, 1961. The 1st of August, 1962, is appointed as the day on which persons must possess the requisite qualifications in order to be entitled to be registered as electors in the revised registers.
