THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

Chapter 280.

UNDER SECTION 50(c) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 280, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Brickdam) Order, 1962.

2. No motor vehicle of any class, nor dray cart, nor other cart whatsoever drawn by animals or pushed by hand shall park in Brickdam on the southern side between High Street and Cornhill Street, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down of passengers, and shall not remain for longer period than is necessary.
