THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, (Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF TRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Importation) Order, 1962.
- 2. From and after the commencement of this Order the importation into British Guiana of all live cattle, sheep, pigs and goats originating from any of the countries set out in the schedule to this Order will be permitted provided that such cattle, sheep, pigs and goats are kept for not less than thirty days prior to export from the United Kingdom in an approved quarantine station in the United Kingdom and are accompanied by a certificate issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries to that effect and showing that such animals are in good health.
- 3. The Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) Order, 1961*, is hereby revoked.
