THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 33 of 1958)

UNDER THE FIRST PROVISO TO SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Mackenzie) Order, 1962.
- 2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, shops in the area described in the first schedule hereto are hereby permitted to open during the hours prescribed in the second schedule hereto.
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall derogate from the provisions of the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Singer Sewing Company) Order, 1960*.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Area to which Order applies)

The Mackenzie area situate on the right bank of the Demerara River commencing from the Kara-Kara River and extending up the left bank of the Kara-Kara River to the Shibaru Creek thence up the left bank of the Shibaru Creek to its source and thence in a straight line due west to the right bank of the Demerara River at Three Friends.

SECOND SCHEDULE

(Hours during which shops may be open)

(a) Mondays, Tuesdays,
Thursdays and Fridays
(b) Wednesdays and Public
Holidays

3.30 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.

(c) Saturdays and S.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. Christmas Eve 3.30 p.m. to 9.15 p.m.
