THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958.

(No. 33 of 1958).

UNDER THE FIRST PROVISIO TO SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Ituni) Order, 1962.

2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, shops in the area described in the first schedule hereto are hereby permitted to open during the hours prescribed in the second schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Area to which Order applies)

The Ituni Townsite situate on the Demerara-Berbice watershed near the source of the Ituni River, on the left bank of the Berbice River, being the area known as Ituni Townsite (165 acres) and defined in the Crown Land Lease No. A5636.

SECOND SCHEDULE

(Hours during which shops may be open)

(a) Mondays, Tuesdays,	8.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.
Thursdays and Fridays	3.30 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.
(b) Wednesdays and Public Holidays	8.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.
(c) Saturdays and	8.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.
Christmas Eve	3.30 p.m. to 9.15 p.m.
