MADE UNDER

THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957,

(No. 34 of 1957).

UNDER SECTION 12A (7) OF THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Diesel Plant) Order, 1962.

2. The diesel electrical generating plant described in the schedule hereto, which is the property of the Government and has been used, or been available, to supply electrical energy in bulk to the Demerara Electric Company, Limited, prior to the completion date of the agreement between the International Power Company, Limited, and the Government as defined in subsection (1) of section 12A of the Electricity Ordinance, 1957, as amended by the Electricity (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, shall be included in the public undertaking referred to in subsection (6) of section 12A of the said Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

1. Two 500 kilowatt, 3 phase, 60/50 cycle, 4160/2400 volts General Motors Corporation Type MH 8 mobile diesel/electric generating sets (serial Nos. 326 and 454) with 1 front wheel bogey, 1 gas engine compressor and 2 sets of instruments for alternative 60 or 50 cycle working together with spare parts and tools, ancillary equipment and records drawings.

2. Two 1000 kilowatt, 3 phase, 50 cycle, 4160 volt General Motors Diesel Limited, Canada, Type M 16 railcar diesel/electric generating sets (serial Nos. G1029 and G1030), together with spare parts and tools, ancillary equipment and records drawings.
