THE INCOME TAX (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1962,

(No. 11 of 1962).

UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 1 OF THE INCOME TAX (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1962, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Income Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962 (Commencement of Certain Provisions) Order, 1962.

2. The following provisions of the Income Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1963 —

- (a) section 26;
- (b) paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of section 28;
- (c) paragraph (a) of section 34;
- (d) sections 36 and 43.
