ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order 1964.

2. Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the addition thereto after the second proviso at the end of Division 99 of the following new proviso —

“Provided further that brassieres imported from all sources of a value not exceeding \$18.00 per dozen C.I.F. (British West Indian Currency) shall be subject to an additional duty of \$3.00 per dozen.”
