ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 71)

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cole (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1964.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policies of insurance in the sum of two thousand dollars, and five hundred dollars, effected on the life of STEPHEN WILLIAM COLE with the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, and the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company, respectively, under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said STEPHEN WILLIAM COLE and his wife CLARICE EVELYN COLE and to pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increases thereon.
