THE DEFENCE (PENSIONS AND GRATUITIES) REGULATIONS

(Cap. 15:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON THE DEFENCE BOARD BY REGULATION 20 (2) (h) OF THE DEFENCE (PENSION AND GRATUITIES) REGULATIONS, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE BY THE DEFENCE BOARD:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Pensions and Gratuities) (Determination of Reckonable Service) Order 1979, and shall be deemed to have come into operation immediately after the commencement of the Defence (Pensions and Gratuities) Regulations. Citation and commencement.
2. For the purposes of the Regulations, service as an employee in the Transport and Harbours Department to whom the Transport and Harbours Department (Superannuation and other Benefits) Regulations apply is hereby determined as reckonable service if a soldier or an officer had such service as an employee prior to service as a soldier or as an officer. Determination of reckonable service for superannuation purposes.

Provided that where the service as a soldier or as an officer was not immediately preceded by service as an

employee in the Transport and Harbours Department the last-mentioned period of service shall not be taken into account in computing pension or gratuity, except with the approval of the Defence Board.
