MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,
(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Plantation Calcutta) Order, 1964.

2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

SCHEDULE

An area of land known as Plantation Calcutta, situate on the East Coast of Demerara and bounded as follows—
