## ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964.  
(No. 8 of 1964).

UNDER REGULATION 25(1) OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I, BEING SATISFIED THAT IT IS NECESSARY AND EXPEDIENT IN THE INTERESTS OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER TO REGULATE THE ENTRY OF PERSONS INTO THE AREA SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDER, HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Protected Area) Order, 1964, and shall come into force on the 11th day of July, 1964.

2. The area specified in the Schedule to the Emergency Powers (Curfew) (No. 2) Order, 1964, is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purposes of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1964, and no person who was not at the beginning of the 11th day of July, 1964, resident therein shall be present therein except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Police Officer commanding "C" Division or the Officer Commanding "B" Company, 1st Battalion, The Queen's Own Buffs.
