MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1964.
- 2. The rates of import duties of customs specified in Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, are hereby increased by the substitution of the rates of duty specified in respect of the items and classifications in the schedule to this Order for the rates of duty specified in respect of the corresponding items and classifications in Part I of the schedule aforesaid.
- 3. Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the addition thereto after the provisos at the end of Division 99 of the following proviso —

"Provided further that chairs (all kinds) to which item 821-01.1 applies, when imported from any source, shall be subject to an additional duty of \$5.00 on each chair".
