THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (VALUATION OF PROPERTY)
ORDINANCE, 1959,

(No. 5 of 1959).

UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (VALUATION OF PROPERTY) ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Preparation of Valuation Lists) (Extension of Time) Order, 1964.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Local Government (Preparation of Valuation Lists) Order, 1963*, the date on which the first list referred to in the said Order shall come into operation shall be the 2nd day of January, 1965

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Local Government (Preparation of Valuation Lists) Order, 1963, made under section 5 of the Local Government (Valuation of Property) Ordinance, 1959, appointed the 2nd January, 1965, as the date for the coming into operation of the first valuation list prepared under the new system of valuation introduced by the Local Government (Valuation of Property) Ordinance, 1959. It is not practicable for the list to come into operation on the date appointed and this Order appoints another date for that purpose.
