# THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1964.
- 2. The import duties of customs specified in Part I of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, on the articles set out in the schedule hereto are hereby increased to the extent indicated therein.
- 3. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the insertion of the following sub-item in item 27 thereof—
  - "(13) Chemicals which the Comptroller is satisfied are imported solely for use in the manufacture of detergents and liquid bleach or either of such products."
