MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, (No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Plantation Susannah) Order, 1964.
- 2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.
- 3. The fee payable in respect of the first registration of any land in the area defined in the schedule to this Order shall be five dollars.

SCHEDULE

The eastern half of an area of land known as Plantation Susannah, situate on the East Coast of Berbice and bounded as follows —

On the north — by the Atlantic Ocean.

On the south — by the northern edge of the Grand Canal reserve.

On the east — by the common boundary along the side line dam between the eastern half of Plantation Susannah

and Plantation Bohemia.

On the west — by the common boundary between the eastern half of Plantation Susannah and the western half of Plantation Susannah.
