ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 7) Order 1964.

2. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition to Item 27 thereof of the following sub-item —

“(14) Raw materials and containers which the Comptroller is satisfied are imported solely for use in the manufacture of paints, varnishes, pigments, and painting products.”
