## ORDER

## THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT.

(Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Diplomatic Complex) Order 1977.

2. The land described in the schedule, upon which it is proposed to site a Diplomatic Complex for Foreign Missions in Guyana is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of it for the public work aforesaid.

## SCHEDULE

That portion of land including Areas "C", "F", "O", "G", "H", "K", "N" and "J" being part of the frontlands of Plantation Turkeyen, situate on the East Coast of Demerara, Guyana, and bounded as follows:

On the North	:	By the concrete Sea Wall between Plantation Liliendaal and Plantation Cummings Lodge
On the East	:	By the Road known as the University of Guyana Access Road
On the South	:	By the Railway Reserve
On the West	:	By the Road between Plantation Turkeyen and Plantation Liliendaal.

The aforesaid portion of land is shown on a compiled plan prepared by the Survey Division of the Ministry of Works and Housing (Works), Kingston, Georgetown, on record as Drawing No. BD 190 dated 4th January, 1977.
