THE SPIRITS ACT

(Cap. 82:24)



IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 75(3) OF THE SPIRITS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Methylation Order,* may be cited as the Methylation (Amendment) Order 1977.
2. Clause 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion of the following definition immediately after the definition of "Wood Naphtha" —

"Pure Methanol or Methyl Alcohol. — A colourless inflammable poisonous liquid which is prepared synthetically";.
3. Clause 3 of the Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects —
 - (a) by the insertion of the words "or Pure Methanol — 1.8 gallons" immediately after the words "Wood Naphtha — 2 gallons" wherever those words appear in paragraph (a);
 - (b) by the insertion of the words "or Pure Methanol — 4.05 gallons" immediately after the words "Wood Naphtha — 4.5 gallons" wherever those words appear in paragraph (b); and
 - (c) by the insertion of the words "or with pure methanol in the proportion of not less than 4.5% by volume" immediately after the words "5% by volume".
