THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT (Chapter 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PUR-POSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Guyana State Corporation Development Complex) Order 1977.

2. The proposed construction for the extension of warehousing and wharfage facilities for the Guyana State Corporation on the lands described in the schedule hereunder is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said lands for the purposes of surveying or otherwise examining such lands with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such lands for the construction of the public work aforesaid.
