THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 179)

UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE. IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of lands for Public Purposes (Amendment) Order, 1963, and shall be read with the Acquisition of Land for Public Purposes Order, 1958* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.
- 2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the schedule thereto and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"SCHEDULE

Two pieces of land bordered in red and blue and marked Lot 'M' and Lot 'N' respectively, being parts of Section "A" of the East Half of Nabaclis situate on the East Coast of Demerara, in the county of Demerara and the Colony of British Guiana, the said Lot 'M' containing an area of .8996 English acre and the said Lot 'N' containing an area of .1085 English acre, as defined and shown on a plan by Lachman Singh, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 26th day of September, 1958 and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as Plan No. 8516".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

Order in Council No. 70 of 1958 declared that a certain tract of land was required for the construction of a public work in the nature of a health centre. The description set out in the schedule to that Order, however, was not based upon the plan paid before the Governor in Council in accordance with section 6 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Ordinance, Chapter 179. This Order substitutes a description of the land based upon the correct plan.
