ORDER Made Under

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963 (No. 7 of 1963)

WHEREAS it is necessary for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that certain articles on board the Steamship Arakaka for the time being within British Guiana be requisitioned:

NOW THEREFORE under regulation 36 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1963, and in accordance with article 22 of the Constitution of British Guiana and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, it is hereby ordered by the Governor as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Requisition of Articles on Board the Arakaka) Order, 1963.
 - 2.(1) In this Order -

"the vessel" means the Steamship Arakaka; and "the master" means the master of the vessel and includes any person for the time being in charge of the vessel.

- (2) In this Order the Competent Authority means the Minister of Works and Hydraulics and includes any person authorised in writing by him to perform any of his functions under this Order. Any person so authorised shall act subject to such directions as may from time to time be given by the Competent Authority.
- (3) The Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Trade and Industry shall be deemed to have been authorised for the purposes of the immediately preceding paragraph to perform all the functions of the Competent Authority under this Order.
- 3. Subject to the provision for the payment of compensation under regulation 37 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1963, the articles specified in the schedule hereto consigned to or intended for delivery in British Guiana and on board the vessel in British Guiana at the date of the commencement of this Order are hereby requisitioned.
- 4. No person shall remove or cause to be removed any article requisitioned under this Order from the vessel except with the permission in writing of the Competent Authority.

- 5. The master shall cause the vessel to be moored at such wharves or places as the Competent Authority may direct so as to enable the Competent Authority to have access to any article requisitioned under this Order for the purpose of removing, discharging or unloading that article.
- 6. The master shall permit the Competent Authority to board the vessel for the purpose of removing, discharging or unloading any article requisitioned under this Order and on board the vessel.
- 7. The Competent Authority may do all such acts and things as may be reasonably necessary for him to take such part of the articles requisitioned under this Order as he may from time to time require.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Dried fish.
- (2) Tapioca, sago and other seeds.
- (3) Tea.
- (4) Salt.
- (5) Tinned foodstuff.
- (6) Alum.
