ORDER  
Made UnderTHE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963.  
(No. 7 of 1963)

UNDER REGULATION 31 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1963,  
AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN  
THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY  
AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Regulation of Petroleum Products) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Emergency Powers (Regulation of Petroleum Products) Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order and any other Order amending the same.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended -

(a) by the deletion of the figures and words -

"(3) Gas Oil 48/52 D.1

(4) Marine Diesel

(5) Bunker "C" (Fuel Oil)"

in the first schedule thereof; and

(b) by the deletion of the figures and words -

"(3) Gas Oil 48/52 D.1

(4) Marine Diesel

(5) Bunker "C" (Fuel Oil)"

in the second schedule thereof.
